

Save The Geese

Job description – *harassment maintenance*

PURPOSE: To reduce and maintain the number of Canada geese in Collins Park to thirty (30) or less.

METHOD: Volunteers will fill initially four (4) shifts per day with water and land harassment. Preferably two (2) boaters and one (1) land chaser with a dog.

EXPLANATION: Shifts initially will be:

5am-7am

10am-12pm

3pm-5pm

7pm-9pm

PROCEDURE:

1. Boaters will put in at Collins Lake or The Mohawk River by Jumpin' Jacks as needed. Boaters will paddle at geese and be a noise nuisance.
2. Land chasers will not permit geese to land on grounds within park.
3. Number of geese should be recorded at the start and conclusion of each shift on clipboard in storage area.
4. Equipment should be removed from and replaced to storage area.
5. If there are no geese in the park, lake or river in close proximity volunteers should patrol park for goose droppings and clean as necessary. Volunteers should bring plastic bags and/or gloves or other cleaning materials as needed.
6. Volunteers may assist parks supervisor Jim Marx as directed. Activities may include, but not be limited to placement of silhouettes, or other harassment materials.
